Numbers 21.4-9; Psalm 107.1-3, 17-22; Ephesians 2.1-10; John 3.14-21

Of course, we offer extemporary or unstructured prayer to God as well. The Anglican Church of Australia has three official collections of liturgies. In chronological order they are:

- The Book of Common Prayer, 1662 (BCP)
- An Australian Prayer Book, 1978, (AAPB)
- A Prayer Book for Australia, 1995, (APBA)

In AAPB the theme for today, the 4th Sunday in Lent, is "new life". Very appropriate as we recall the way in which this new and eternal life is offered to us in the Gospel reading today. It is all through Jesus- believe in Him, follow Him, give Him the glory!
