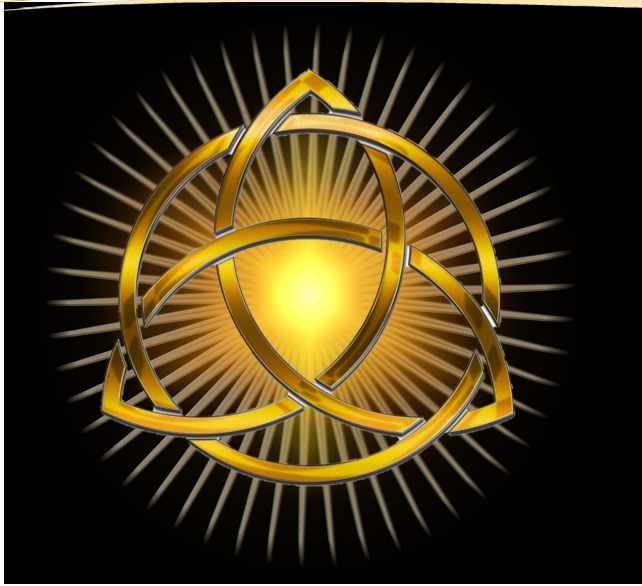

Many people will know that there is one icon that I am particularly keen on and that is Rublev's Trinity which is displayed in my home and often seen in the background during prayers. The Icon was painted by Russian painter Andrei Rublev in the 15th century and depicts three characters, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. There has been much written and said in relation to the Icon but for me it encapsulates the basis of our faith and our journey together.

When you look at the characters they appear to almost be dancing together, united, and supportive of each other. For me they represent community and the essence of not only the Blessed Trinity, but of our Christian life. The teamwork demonstrated by the Holy Trinity is a model for community living and the character of the relationships we are called live in our daily Christian journey, not only within the Church but with all our sisters and brothers in the world, no matter who they are or what they believe or think. Our lives should reflect the grace we find in the Holy Trinity.
