
Mark 1:16-18

DEING CHULLD DO PEOPLE HEAR GOD'S VOICE WHEN THEY'RE CALLED BY HIM?


Sometimes it sounds like a real voice – Samuel thought it was Eli calling him at first. But mostly God calls right into our being, so he doesn't need to vocalise it.

CAN YOU MISS HEARING GOD GETTING IN TOUCH WITH YOU?


