Then he makes the surprising claim that he can rebuild the temple in three days. After the resurrection, his disciples looked back on this day and realised that Jesus was the temple and he did return. How do we believe without the disciples' first-hand experience? Where do we experience the resurrection?

Priest's Ponderings

The Third Temple was started before Jesus' birth. Herod meant it to be grander than Zerubbabel's rebuild after the exile in Babylon. It was incomplete at the A.D. 30 Passover. It was under construction when

Jesus was presented as a baby and when, at Twelve years of age, he sat among the teachers of the Law of Moses. Herod's pride and joy, it was really a political bribe to hostile constituents. This was he who ordered the slaughter of the Holy Innocents. His son, Herod Antipas, (whom Jesus called "The Fox"; Luke 13:32), took the head of John the Baptist, and mocked the Saviour at his trial.

There was a commercial undercurrent to Herod's Temple. There had to be animals without blemish and coin without images for sacrifice. These were all on sale at premium rates. (Profit before prayer.)

In an attack premeditated from Eternity, Jesus and his followers dish out a restatement of the Divine Judgment which had come on "Babylon the Great", Sodom and Gomorrah and the antediluvian world.

Four decades later, Titus' troops totally trashed that Third Temple.
