PHILIPPIANS 2 v. 5~8

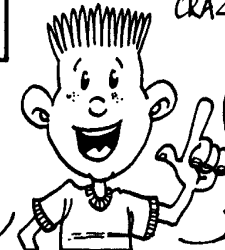

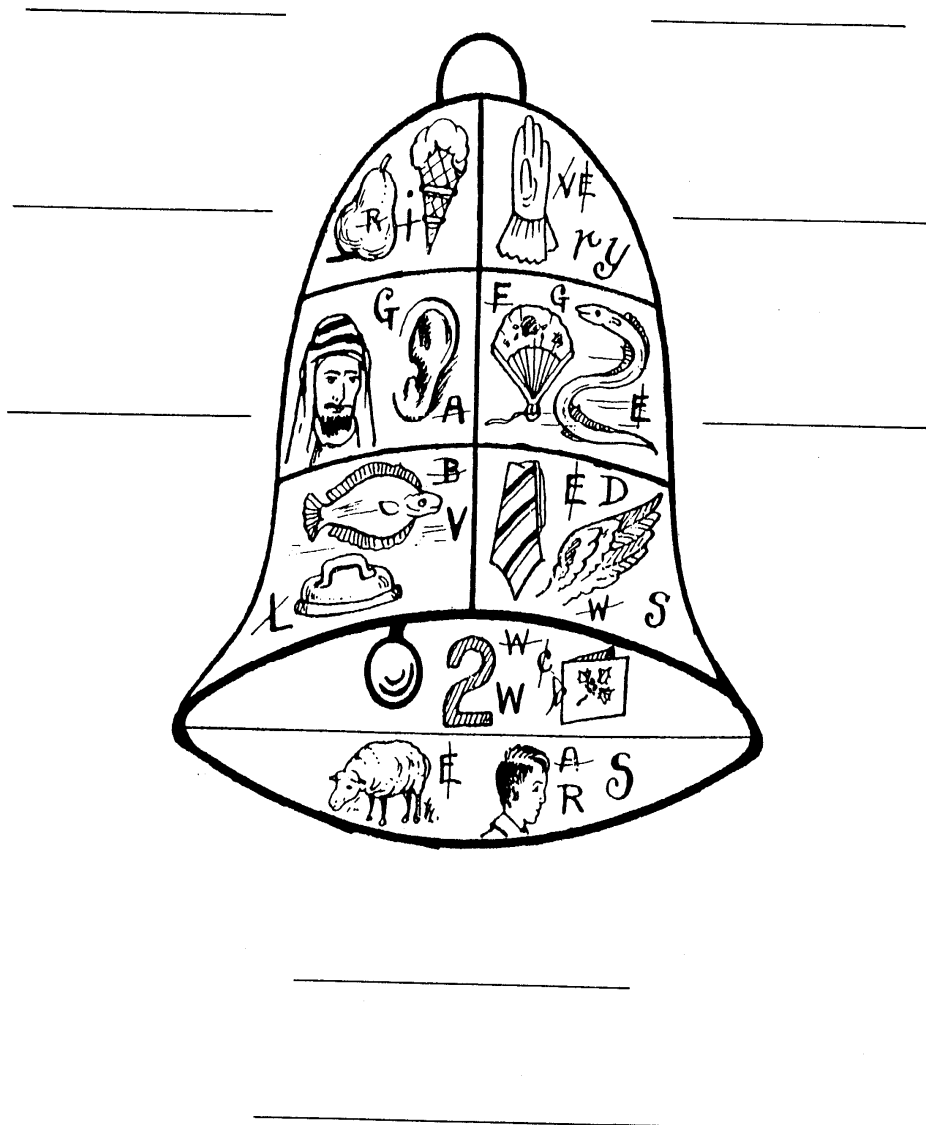
