

PP's 5th December

Sing Along with Zechariah and the Mandeans!

They meet beside the Nepean River, in their long white robes. They revere John the Baptist. They come from Iraq, rescued by Anglicans from slaughter by Islamic State. They hold that Zechariah, the aged father of John the Baptist, was a prophet of God because God spoke directly through him, just like another Zechariah who wrote the second-last book in the Old Testament. They are the Mandeans, the last of the Gnostics from the Third Century.

For the Second Sunday in Advent, we rehearse "The Song of Zechariah", or "Benedictus", rejoicing with Zechariah and Elizabeth at the birth of their son, the forerunner of his second-cousin, Jesus of Nazareth, the long-awaited Messiah.

In these words we rehearse the immutable will of the eternal Father-God: that all humanity will discover the "Jewel of Great Price"; that "the dawn from on high would break upon us". We respond to the challenge: "Prepare the way of the Lord!" ... And we still do, even today. ... 'because the Light which enlightens everyone was coming into the world.'



SECOND SUNDAY IN ADVENT

Malachi 3.1-14; For the Psalm Song of Zechariah; Philippians 1.1-11; Luke 3.1-6

Luke's gospel quotes the prophet Isaiah about the preparation required for a royal visit—the road cleared, smoothed and straightened, valleys filled, and hills flattened. A dramatic picture indeed! In a similar way the people's moral and spiritual state needed drastic action in their deep need to repent, in readiness for the coming of the Messiah, Christ Jesus.
