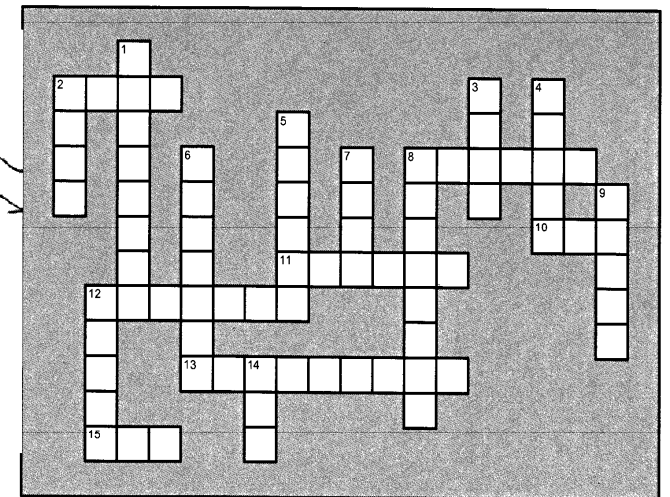

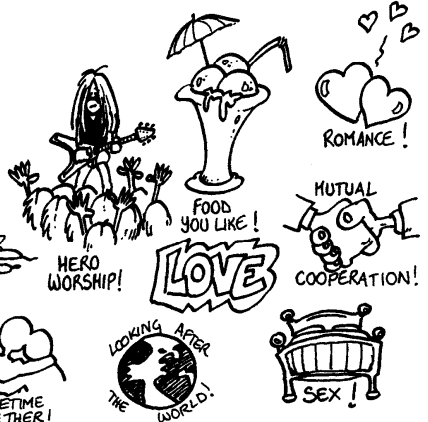


LOVE ONE ANOTHER

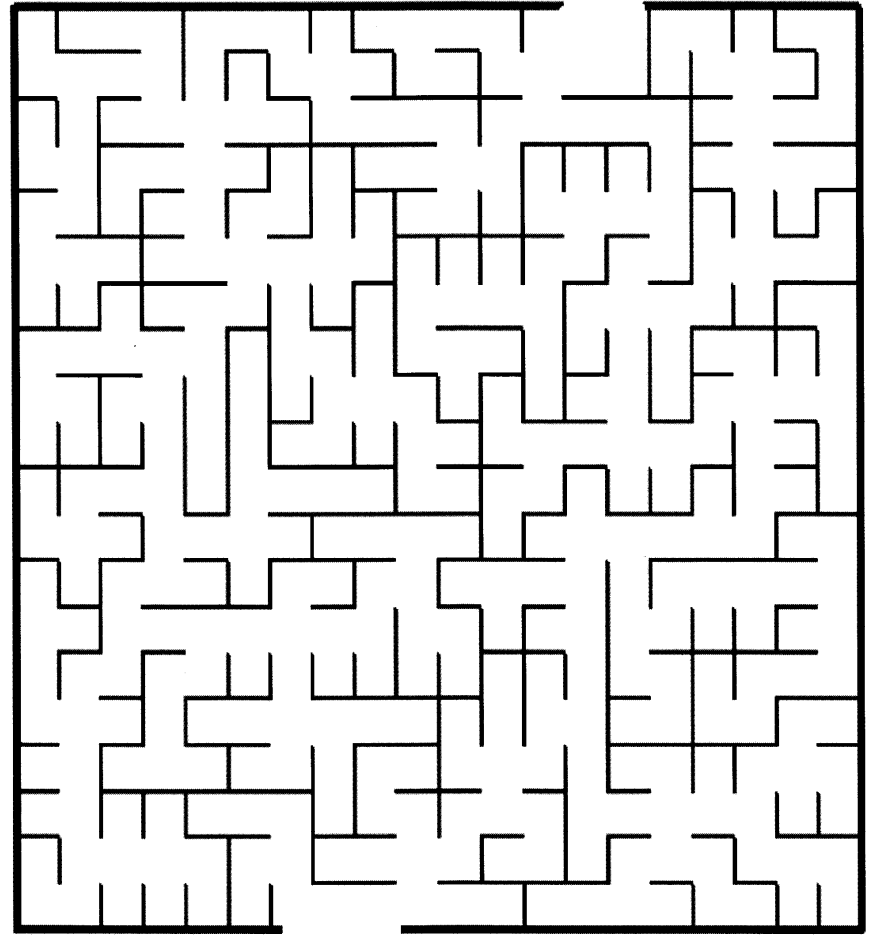
