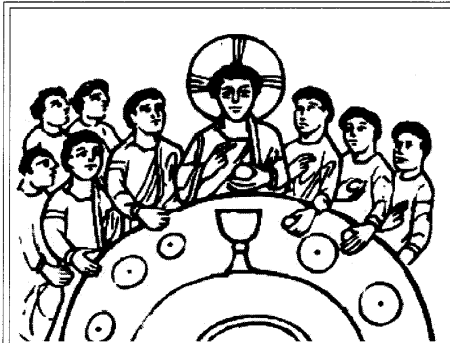

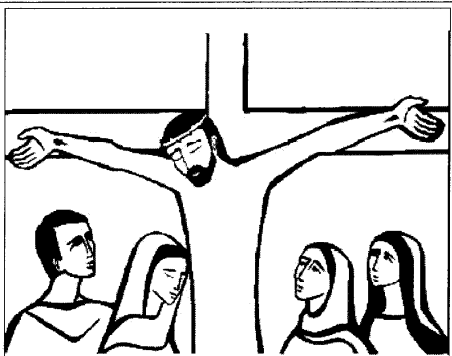
Color the pictures and learn about the last week before Easter. Ask your parents or teacher to tell the story to you this week.



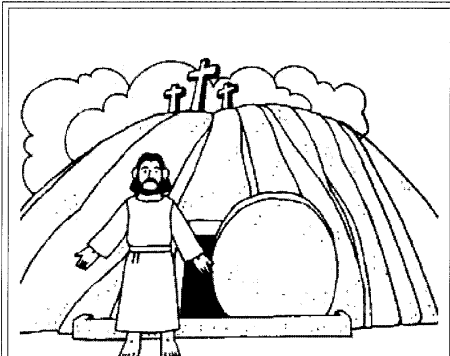

Dear Father, we sometimes make bad choices. Thank you for being a loving Father who will always take us back when we come home to you. In Jesus' name we pray, **Amen**

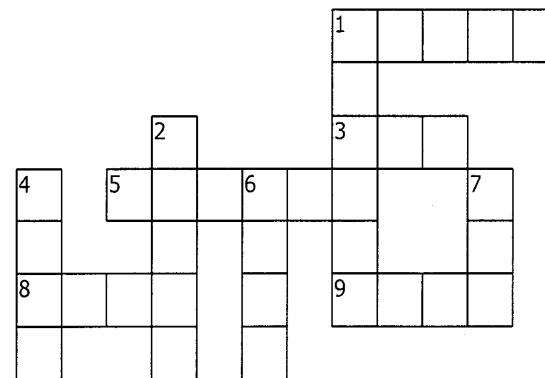


The Lost Son Returns

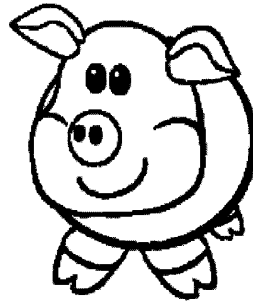

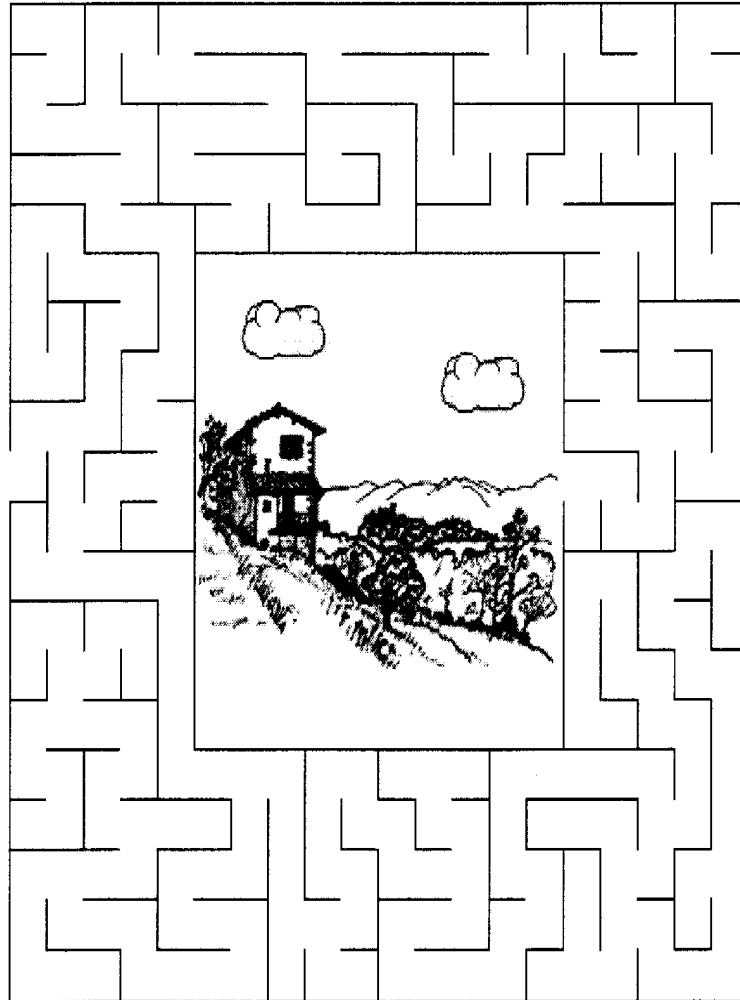
