**Amen.**



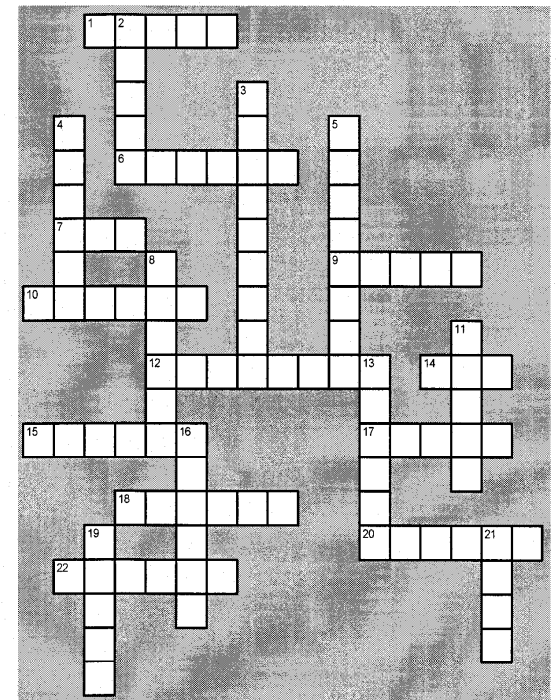

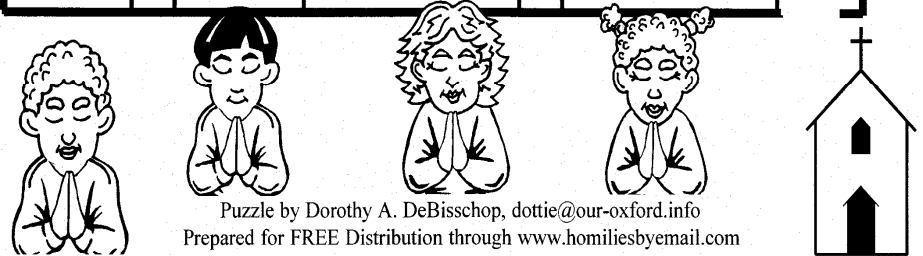
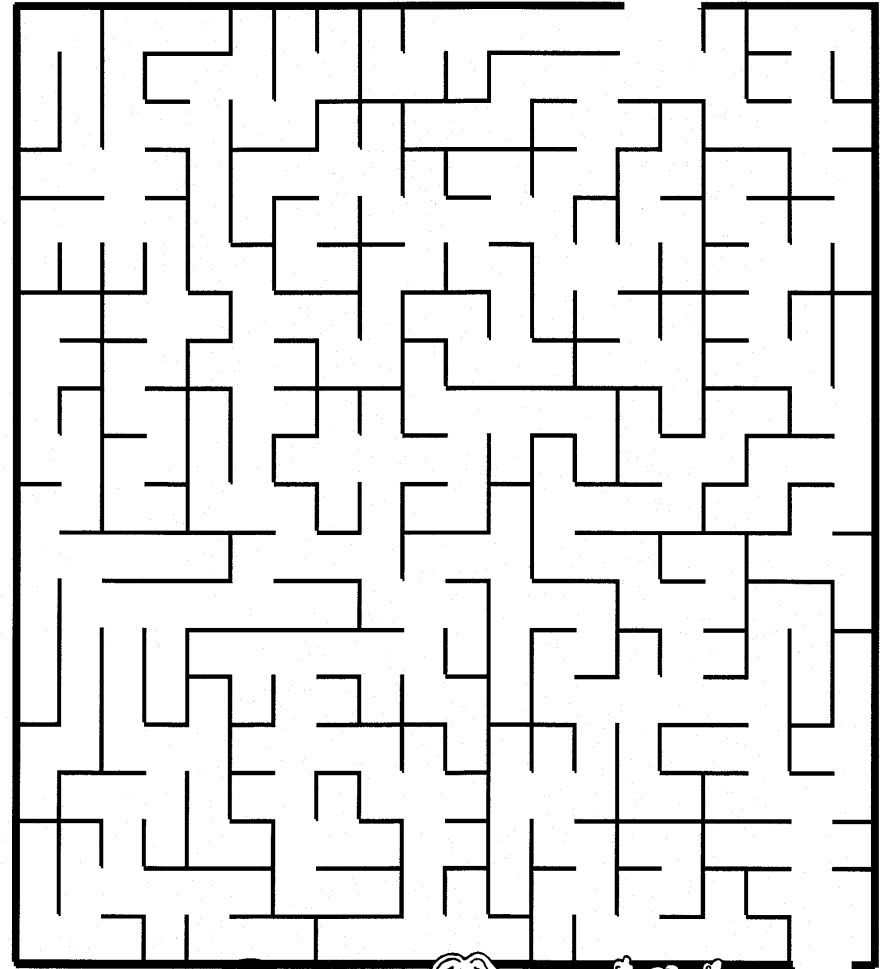
