Colour in the warehouses, barns and silos you think store heavenly riches.

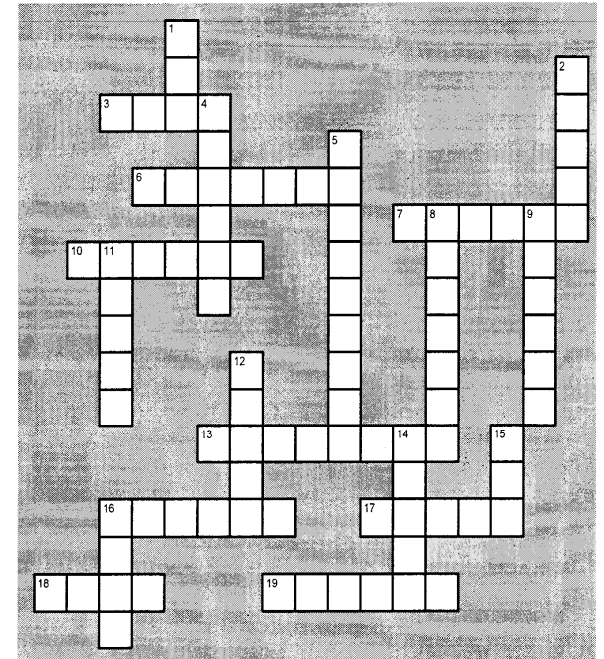
