

Here during this All Saints' tide, our celebration is three-fold: the Eve of All Saints' (All Hallows' Eve or Hallowe'en), All Saints' Day, when we remember the most notable people whose lives were dedicated to following Jesus, and finally All Souls' Day, when we recall and give thanks for the great multitude which no-one can number, including all the Godly people who have been part of our family here in Taree, many of whose examples still continue.

This entire holy period points us to our lives here on earth along with our lives and the lives of so many others who now live in the nearer presence of our loving Father God. As Christians, we believe in a continuum with those who have gone before us (the Communion of Saints), with the only difference for each of us being that we shuffle off our mortal bodies and, as Saint Paul reminds us, each of us takes upon ourself a new and different body.

None of this is earned by our deeds but by our being God's active people in this earthly life. In doing so, we are His dedicated people, His saints, in the present. Let Wesley have the last word...
