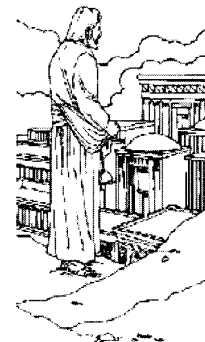

In the desert, Jesus thought very hard about his life. He was tempted to disobey God.

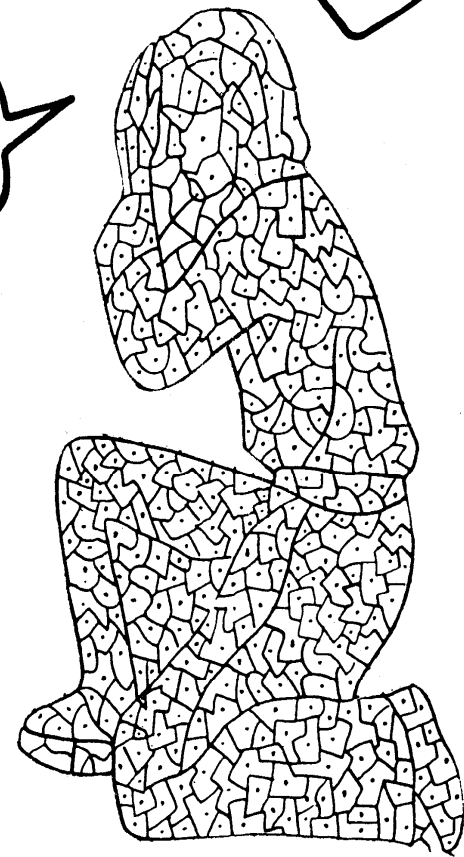

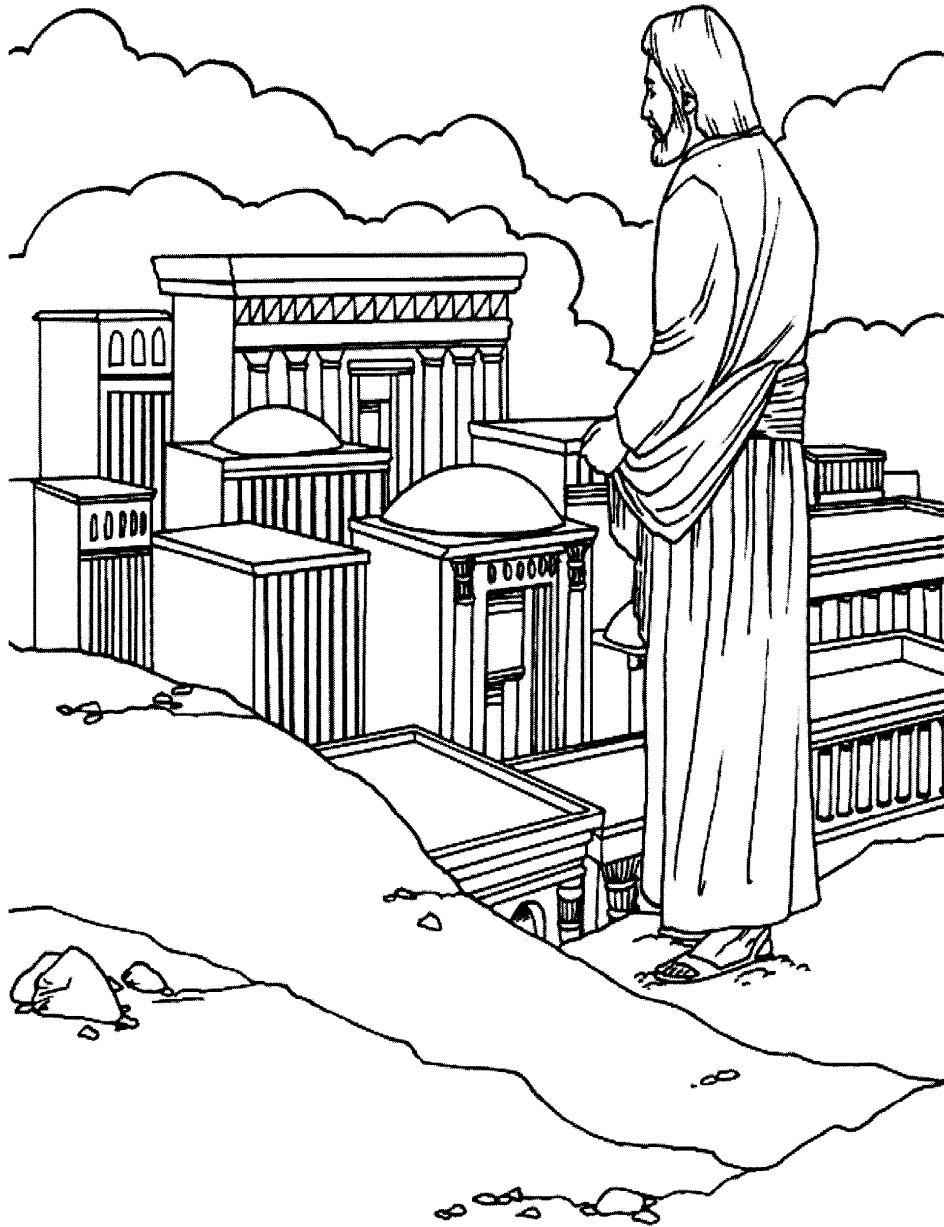
