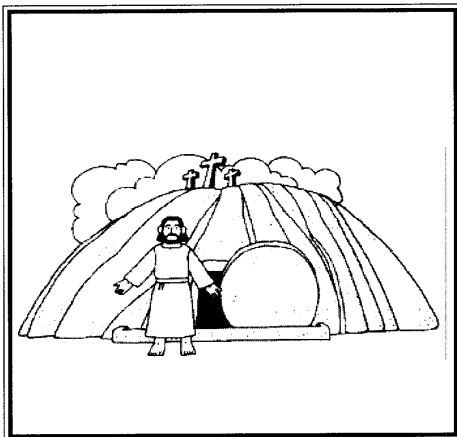
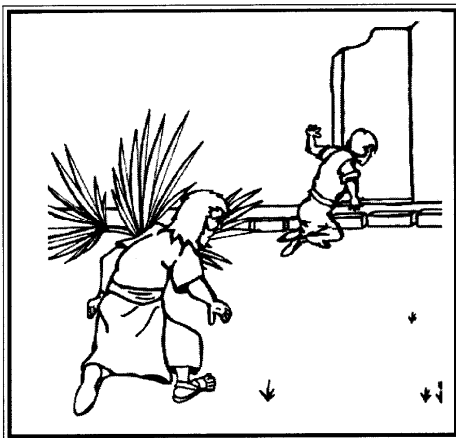

Ask your parents to help tell the story to you this week.



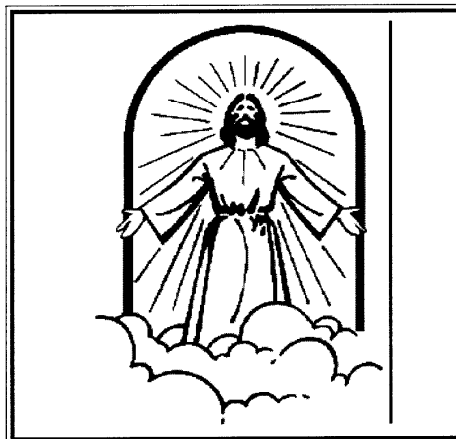
Jesus rose after he died on the cross

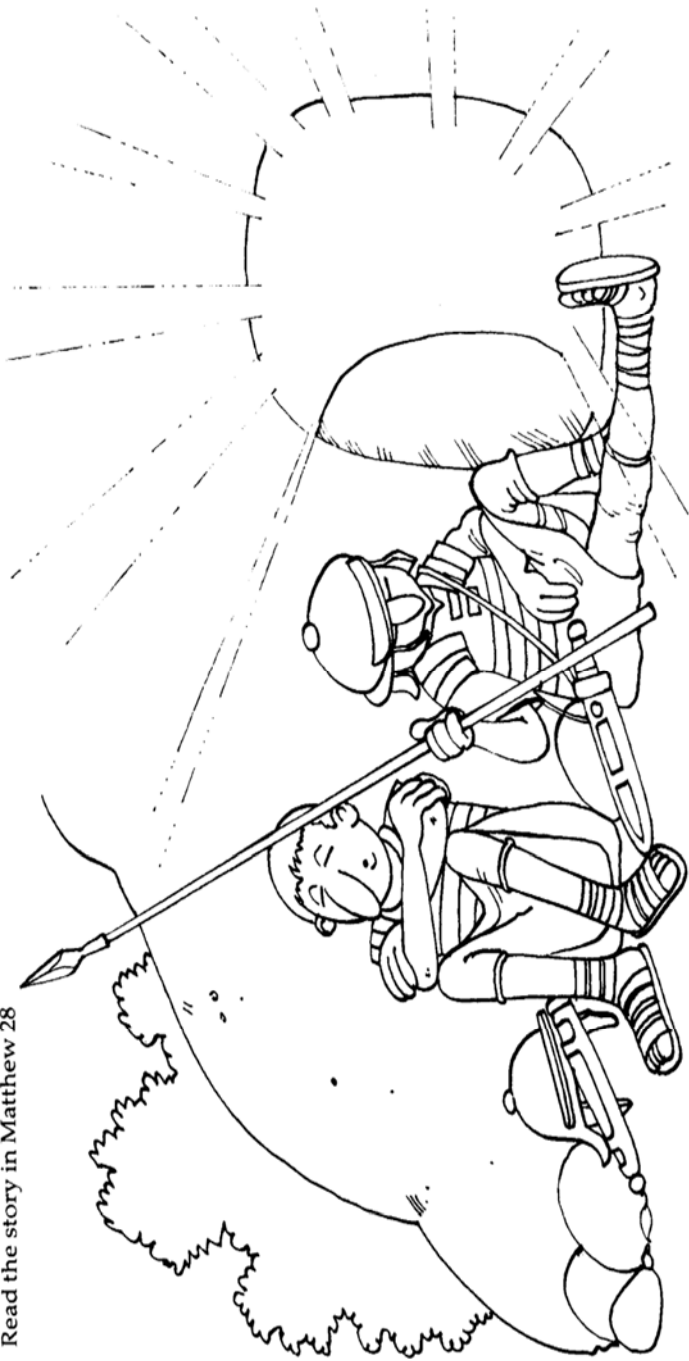
## Easter Sunday 31 March, 2024

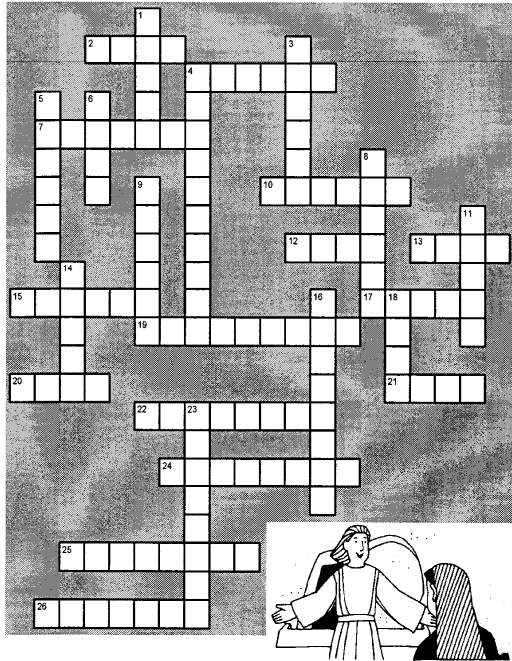

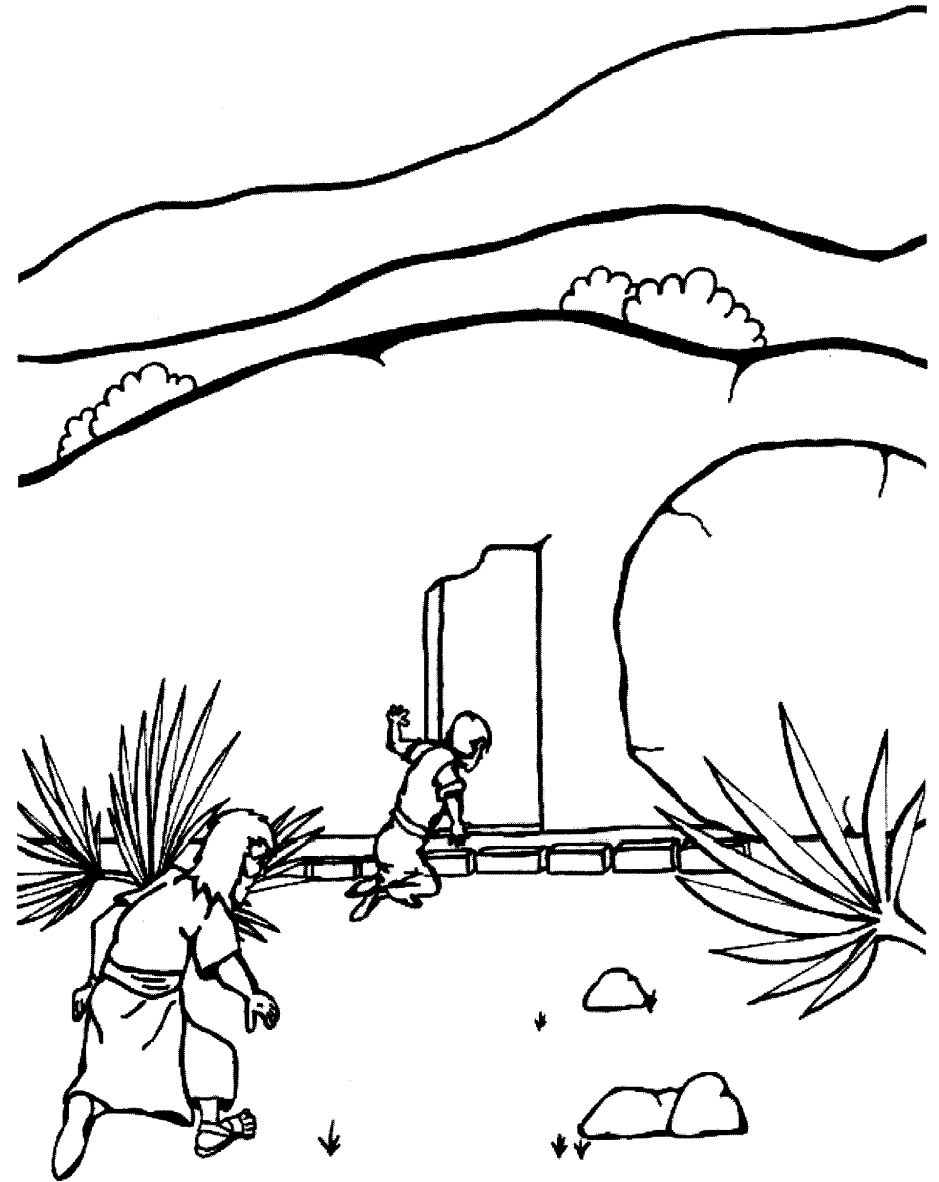

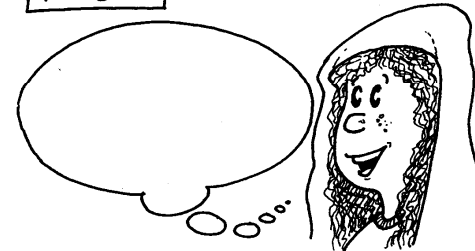

**JESUS IS ALIVE!**  
 IT'S JUST SO INCREDIBLE-I MEAN, NO ONE CAN DIE LIKE THAT AND THEN COME BACK TO LIFE, CAN THEY?  
 No! And the followers of Jesus who knew him well were just as confused as you.  
 SO DID IT REALLY HAPPEN, OR WAS IT JUST WISHFUL THINKING?  
 Well, plenty of people were so certain they had met the risen Jesus that they spent their whole lives spreading the news.  
 IF JESUS REALLY ROSE FROM THE DEAD, THAT MEANS HE'S JUST AS FULLY ALIVE THIS MINUTE.  
 Yes, that's right, he is!

- The sealed tomb was empty
- The tomb was guarded
- Many were willing to die rather than deny the Resurrection - they knew it was true
- If he had not actually died Jesus would have been weak and ill, which he wasn't
